6AM+	GO Train from Guelph to Union Station Toronto	Trains leave Guelph Center station as follows: 6:07AM – Arrives Union Station 7:43AM 6:32AM – Arrives Union Station 7:56AM 7:12AM – Arrives Union Station 8:48AM
8AM+	Subway from Union Station to Queens Park	Use the Yonge -University Subway Line northbound and get off at the Queens Park stop. Queens Park is located just north of the Queens Park stop. Trains leave every 3 minutes for the 5-minute ride to Queens Park. 4 stops from Union Station
8:30AM to 9:15AM	Meet at Queens Park. Mike Schreiner's office - Room 451	Enter through the Main entrance of Queens Park. Those attending Queens Park must submit names in advance to mike.pride@icloud.com. SOW signs, buttons & badges are <u>not</u> permitted. You will need to show ID to proceed through security. Once inside Queens Park take elevator to 4 th floor and go to Mike Schreiner's office - Room 451. You will be able to leave your coats, purses and mobile phones in Mike's office. Mobile phones are permitted in the Media Center but not in the Assembly.
